

Public use of facilities, land and water surfaces of Canyon Lake is governed by certain laws and regulations. All laws of the State of Texas pertaining to public conduct apply. Additionally, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 327, sets forth expected standards of park use. These are based on safe practice and common sense, but many are unfamiliar to the first-time visitor. Following is a list of the most often violated provisions of these regulations:

*****FOR EMERGENCIES DIAL 911*****

1. Camping is limited to 14 days in a 30-day period; **checkout time is at 2 pm.**
2. Visitors who are not camping must leave by 10pm. (36 CFR 327.12)
3. **Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 6 am.** These will be enforced. (36 CFR 327.12)
4. Radios or car stereos must be kept at a sound level that will not disturb other campers and visitors. (36 CFR 327.12)
5. **Fireworks or loaded firearms are prohibited.** (36 CFR 327.13)
6. Rock fire rings or ground fires are prohibited. Fires must be confined to grills or metal fire rings designated for that purpose. **DO NOT MAKE ROCK FIRE RINGS.** (36 CFR 327.10)
7. **Cutting trees or tree limbs is prohibited.** Gathering of dead wood on the ground is permitted provided that the wood is used in the park. (36 CFR 327.14)
8. Vehicles parked/used off roads is prohibited at Canyon Lake. (36 CFR 327.2)
9. Swimming is at your own risk. (36 CFR 327.5)
10. **Pets must be kept on a leash not longer than six feet in length, at all times.** No pets allowed on beaches. Pets may not be left outside, unattended. (36 CFR 327.11)

11. **Swimming, sun bathing, or fishing on or around boat ramps or docks is prohibited.** (36 CFR 327.5)
12. Keep campsites and park grounds free of litter; **deposit trash in receptacles provided.** (36 CFR 327.11)
13. Discharge of grey or black water is strictly prohibited. (36 CFR 327.9)
14. **Persons shall be responsible for proper removal and disposal of any waste produced by animals.** (36 CFR 327.11)
15. **Visitors must obey all posted signs and restrictions.** (36 CFR 327.12)
16. Group shelters and group camping facilities are available in some parks. Call (830) 964 – 3341 for details and reservations.

Campsite Rules


- Maximum of 10 persons/single-use campsite (including visitors);
 - Maximum of two camping units per single-use campsite (1 RV + 1 Tent, 1 Trailer + 1 Tent, 2 Tents);
 - Maximum of 2 vehicles/campsite for overnight occupancy (does not include RV);
 - Maximum 2 extra vehicles/campsite between 7 am – 10 pm (does not include recreational unit);
 - Vehicles = anything that requires a parking space;
 - Vehicles with visitor passes must exit the park by 10 pm.
- **Canyon Park Campers will not be allowed to use park amenities in Potters Creek or Cranes Mill unless they pay for a campsite in Cranes Mill or Potters Creek**
